Dear families and friends

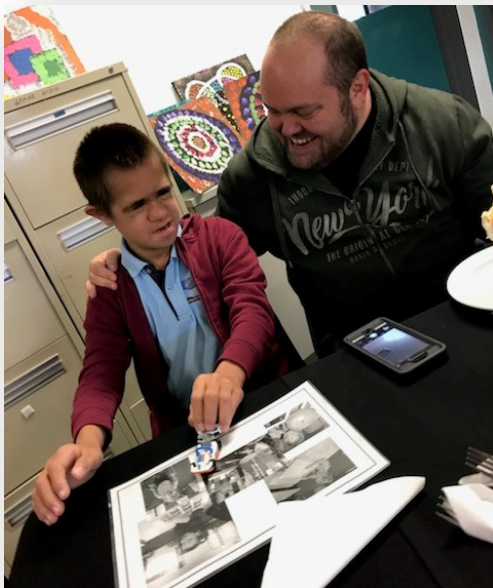
Everyone at HRCS has been extremely busy this week preparing for the upcoming Sports Carnival and Father's Day.

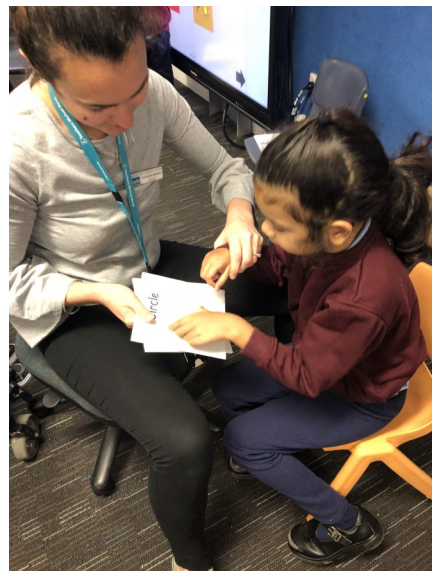
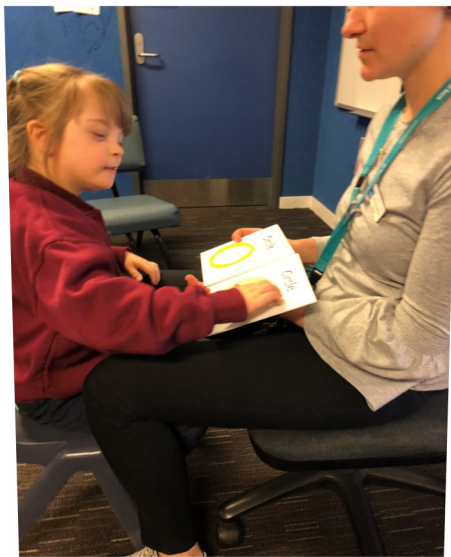
HUB C have been learning all about 2D shapes this Term.
